Warning!

Supply voltage!

- Carry out maintenance only in strainless state!
- All electric works are only allowed to be carried out by authorized qualified personnel.



Warning!

Inadmissible operating parameters!

- Make sure that the CS-PM 600 is only operated within the admissible limit values indicated on the type label.

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Application area

2 Application area

The CS-PM 600 is a mobile current- and effective powermeter for big machines (consumers) e.g. air compressors.

With the CS-PM600 it is possible to do the measurements at running machines without requiring a machine stop at all.

External current transformer (with hinges) are clamping around the phases for the current measurement and the voltage is measured with external magnetic measurement tips.

Depending on the used current transformer, currents up to 100A or 600A could be measured.

All measurement data will be transferred via RS485 (Modbus) to a mobile DS 500 where they could be displayed, recorded and analyzed.

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4 Connections CS-PM 600

Supply voltage!




First connect test leads and current transformers to CS-PM600 before voltage test probes and current transformers are applied.

Please ensure that the current transformer is completely closed. (2x Click)

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6 Connection CS-PM600 at DS500 mobile (RS485)

The data transfer from the mobile current power meter to the DS 500 mobile is digital via Modbus (RS485). Please use the CS connection cable 0553 0506.

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6.2 DS 500 mobile settings for CS-PM600

6.2.1 Choice and activation of the CS-PM600


First step: choose an unused sensor channel
Main menu → Settings → Sensor settings → B3

Second step: choose type CS-PM600

Main menu → Settings → Sensor settings → B3 → Type description field CS-PM600

Third step: confirm with OK.

Now, a *Name* (See Installation and operating instructions DS 500 mobile chapter 8.2.2.7 Label and setting the description fields) can be determined.




Textfield Modbus ID

The CS-PM600 is delivered with Modbus ID = 1. Please ensure that Modbus Id = 1 is set.

Modbus settings for CS-PM600

Baudrate: 19600 Stopbits: 1 Parity: None

These settings are also the standard settings.



By pressing button **Measure Range** *100A* or *600A* the measuring range for the current - measurement will be selected.

Depending on the connected current transformers. Wrong selection will lead to <u>incorrect</u> measurement results

By pressing button reset Energy-Counter all stored measurement values will be reseted.
